REC GAMEDAY INFO

Game Day: <u>You'll need 2 roster copies for each game.</u> You'll need referee fees for each game where you are listed as <u>the **HOME** team</u>. Field information and maps are provided by the host club. All Rec schedules are posted on www.BYSL.net. We recommend players arrive 30-minutes before kick-off for a short warm-up and player check-in. *Note, all parents will need to sit separately from the teams. Only approved coaches and players, as shown on the roster can sit with the team during warm-up and games.

Referees/Fees: The Rec referee assigner is Kay Kirkland. She'll coordinate and manage the referees for your scheduled games. The "HOME" team, as designated on the schedule is responsible for paying the game officials/referees. This cost is covered by Central Brevard Soccer and coaches will receive money to pay these on the teams' behalf, usually around the time of uniform distribution. <u>The referees will come to speak to you before each game, request a copy of your roster, and check your team in. During check-in, referees are checking the coaching staff, players, safety equipment, and uniforms.</u>

2022 Fee Schedule: Please use the proceeds provided by CBS to pay the referees before each match that you're listed as the HOME team. Referees will not be able to "make change" for fees. CENTER= center referee. AR = Assistant/Sideline Referee *For U10, there will be one center referee only.

Team Communication: We recommend a free app to use for messaging the team with changes/updates. This could be field/time changes, weather issues, or other communication as directed by the coach. Team App and Team Snap are two of the most commonly used apps for this purpose. If families are willing to rotate post-game treats/snacks weekly, this is a great way to manage that as well.

Inclement Weather: If you can hear thunder, you are within reach of lightning. Activities should be suspended until 30 minutes after the last strike of lightning is seen (or more than 10 MILES away) and after the last sound of thunder is heard. This 30-minute clock restarts for each lightning flash within 10 MILES and each time thunder is heard.

There is no exception to this rule. Everyone, including players, coaches, and spectators, are to take immediate shelter. Field Closures are posted on the club's social media (Instagram & Facebook)

*If the fields are not closed but there are weather concerns, the coaches can make the final decision to practice or cancel.

Goalkeepers: U10+ age groups will have a goalkeeper for each game. Please bring a pinnie (bright-colored training vest provided in your equipment) for your goalkeeper to wear. If you don't have a designated goalkeeper, rotate

players equally (one per quarter or half) so everyone has a chance to learn the position. The goalkeeper (GK) is the only player permitted to use their hands and should wear "goalkeeper gloves"

CBS provides GK training for those players aspiring to learn more about the position and to improve their skills. Ask a Director for more information on these training sessions. They are also posted on our club social media accounts (Facebook & Instagram)
